

## SUMMER BEER FESTIVAL - All you need to know !

**When ?** This year's festival takes place on Fri 13<sup>th</sup>, Sat 14<sup>th</sup> and Sun 15<sup>th</sup> July. 12:00 midday until 10:00p.m. Friday and Saturday and 12:00 midday until 5:00 p.m on Sunday.

**Where ?** It all takes place at The Langton Brewery which is based at Grange Farm, Welham Road, Thorpe Langton, Mkt Harborough, LE16 7TU.

**Do I need to get tickets ?** No. However this year we are also raising money for a small Leicestershire charity, 'Wishes for Kids' - <http://www.wishes4kids.co.uk>, and we are charging £5 per person entry which will cover you for either Friday, Saturday or both! There is no fixed charge on Sunday but if you would like to make a donation to the charity it would be much appreciated.

**Food and Drink.** We will have a range of our own beers along with guest beers from other breweries. The full beer and cider list will be published at the beginning of July. There will also be ciders, lager, wine, Prosecco, gin and soft drinks. Other refreshments provided will include tea, coffee, homemade cakes, pizzas, burgers, sausages and curry. All food is locally sourced and freshly cooked. Vegetarian options are also available.

**Facilities.** This year features new luxury loo blocks and disabled toilet facilities.

**Can we bring children and dogs?** Yes, no problem. Obviously, children are not allowed in the actual bar area and dogs must be kept on leads at all times.

**What happens if it rains?** The main bar area is inside the building and we also have a 40 x 20 ft marquee erected for the whole weekend. We also have further contingency plans if the weekend looks like being very wet. However, this is predominately an outside event so please come dressed appropriately. There's no such thing as bad weather, just the wrong clothing !!

**Entertainment ?** We use all local bands along with some open mic sessions. Friday evening, we have 'Bluesdon', followed by 'The Bar Room Buskers' whilst Saturday we have 'The Whale Band' followed by 'The Levy'. We will also be having a session by vocalist Paul Anderson. Full PA equipment is provided so if you fancy doing an open mic session please give us a ring.

**Camping and Caravanning.** By kind permission from the farmer, we have a field available for those of you who wish to stay over. It is a large flat field and we can take tents, caravans or camper vans. There will be drinking water supply, porta loo, waste tank and waste bins in the field. There is no electrical hook up. Cost is £10 per unit per night. A small tent or awning alongside a camper van would be included in the fee. You may park your vehicle alongside your pitch. Camping is available from Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> and the field must be cleared by Monday 16<sup>th</sup>. STRICTLY NO OPEN FIRES OR FLOOR STANDING BBQ'S. **ADVANCE BOOKING AND PAYMENT IS ESSENTIAL. **Disabled Facilities.** There will be a designated parking area and disabled toilets are provided. There are no steps but this is an outdoor event and the ground can be un-even.
